Committee Reports

First Timers & Return the Favor – Ariel Jones

Thank you to all that submitted information on the Return the Favor program. 1,885 hours were donated to the program. We have four (4) Jaycees participating in the First Timers program this meeting.

Good of the Senate Committee – Alan Richardson
(a) The committee is comprised of the 10 previous Presidents. They met on April 9, 2006 and discussed various items such as “Do we need to operate status quo”. They also began drafting descriptions for the various directors positions. Postcards were sent to 40 or 50 Senators in the Fredericksburg area regarding this meeting to some of them out. (b) We found out that our tax ID is no longer valid and we are working to get it re-activated.

JCI Senate Foundation Scholarships – Anne Johnson
The top two (2) applications were submitted last January and neither of ours won the national award.

No new Senatorships will be awarded at the banquet tonight. However, one will be presented locally in June.

Old Business

President Roth announced that Dan Benka was elected NVP for Region 3 at the MAI meeting held in March 31, 2006 in Williamsport, PA.

New Business

1. MAI Meeting - Chris Williamson mentioned that the last MAI meeting was in Williamsport, PA. We are promoting the 2007 MAI meeting at the Holiday Inn Portsmouth, March 29, 2007 through April 1, 2007. The meeting will coincide with the celebration of the 400th anniversary of the founding of Jamestown and the 200th anniversary of Robert E Lee's birthday. Peggy McHugh will handle registration and hospitality on Thursday. Roz Goin will handle the luncheon on Saturday. John Melleky will coordinate the tours. We are hoping to get a sponsor and the hotel will do breakfast and dinner on Saturday. The meeting is from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon on Saturday. The tours will run for approximately six (6) hours on Friday with a walking tour in the evening that will last approximately two (2) hours. We are expecting 125 to 150 people from NY, NJ, PA, MD, DE, WV and VA. National President Calvin Baerveldt will be attending and other outside visitors. Dan Benka, our recently elected Region 3 VP, and Chris Nunn from NY, Region 2 will be running it.

2. Constitution And By-Law Changes – Most of the proposed changes are grammatical. The motion was made to approve the by-law changes; seconded by _____. The items discussed are as follows:

Constitution:

A. Active

Those Senators who are current in their dues shall be entitled to vote at all meetings and functions, hold office, and receive all Senate publications

Article VIII Quorum – Article VIII NOTICE

Notice of meetings referred to in article V, Section 1 and Articles VI and VII shall require written notice to each active member at least fifteen (15) days prior to said meetings. All other general membership meetings shall require notice at least five (5) days prior to said meeting.

By-Laws:

Article 1 Duties Section 3. Put contact in quotes

Section 6. New Senator Application Advisory Committee – Delete “JCI”

Article III Executive Committee: add The Virginia

Article V – Finance Committee

Article V. FINANCE COMMITTEE

There shall be a standing Finance Committee consisting of five (5) voting members, including the Treasurer, Vice President, Immediate Past President, **and two (2) Senators at Large**, each of whom shall serve a one year term. The Senators at Large shall be appointed by the President with approval from the Executive Committee.

The Treasurer shall serve as chairman of the Finance Committee, which shall meet at least quarterly prior to all regular meetings of the Virginia JCI Senate.

Article 5, Section b. – Correct spelling of “committee”

Article VI – New Senator Application Advisory Committee: Changed JCI to Jaycees.

Policy & Procedures:

Item #1: changed the number of members of the Nominations and Elections Committee to 3, from 4.

Discussed several additional items which need to be addressed including the wording regarding non-Virginia Senators and the elections being held at the “February” meeting. These items will be addressed at the Fall meeting.

There being no other discussion Stu Shatz called question. Motion passed.

President Bryant Blankenship joined the meeting. He thanked the Senators for their 1,885 hours in the Return the Favor program. He mentioned that the VA Jaycees were down 91 members the first three months of his year. However, they are plus 4 new members in April. They are down by 56 members so far for the month of May. Please continue doing the Return the Favor program.

From the South/East: Take I-64 West to Exit 242A (Route 199 West). Follow 199 to fourth light. Take a right onto Jamestown Road. Follow Jamestown Road approximately two miles until reaching a 4-way intersection. Turn to the extreme left onto Richmond Road. Continue on Richmond Road until the first stoplight. Take a left into the Zable parking lot.
