What is a JCI Senatorship?

- It is the highest award presented to a Jaycee by Junior Chamber International (JCI).
- It is given to current and past members who have served the Virginia Jaycees on the state level with support at the local, national and international levels.
- It is given to less than 1% of all members in the Jaycee organization.

What does the Virginia JCI Senate do?

- Assists the Virginia Jaycees, including sponsorship of First Timers & Return the Favor Programs.
- "Return the Favor" provides assistance to the state and local chapters.
- Supports the legacy of the Jaycees, by reaffirming through fellowship and activities that the Creed still matters

Who is eligible?

- Junior Chamber members for at least five years
- Served in an elected or appointed capacity on at least the state level, which includes chapter president and state director. Applications are subject to the approval of the Senate Review Committee

How do I nominate someone?

- Contact the VA JCI Senate Liaison (contact info below)
- Complete the VA JCI Senate application, the US JCI Senate application, and submit both (usually via the Liaison) with the payments listed. You can find the applications on www.vajcisenate.org.
- Work with the VA Senate Liaison or an Active Senator from your chapter to submit the best possible nomination.
- **Note:** A nomination does not indicate automatic acceptance into the organization. For any nominations that are not approved, all monies will be refunded.

What is the cost?

- \$300 payable to Junior Chamber International
- \$75 payable to the U.S. Jaycees
- \$50 payable to the Virginia JCI Senate ♦ Optional--\$50 for a Senate Medallion
